The World Kickboxing and Karate Union Canada (WKU) welcomes you to the Canadian National Championships. This competition is the launch pad to prepare Canadian athletes and the city of Calgary for hosting of the WKU World Championships in October 2023. The Canadian National Championships will also be hosting the Canada Open Championships where upcoming athletes, ages 3 to adult, can compete as colour belts alongside the qualifying divisions. For the WKU World Championships, Calgary will be host to up to 70 countries from across the world. This will build on Alberta's reputation as a prime destination to host national and international cultural and sporting events.

The National Championships are expected to host 400-500 athletes who will compete in a large-scale elite competition. While these types of opportunities have typically been limited especially for women and children, the Canadian National Championships presents an opportunity to allow for more safety and equality not only in competition but also within the organization. As an example, more divisions have been added specifically for women. Hosting the National Championships will create a sense of pride for martial arts athletes and bring thousands of visitors to Calgary, creating a large public benefit to our local economy.

With immense pride and respect, we acknowledge the traditional territories of the peoples of the Treaty 7 region in Southern Alberta, which includes the Blackfoot First Nation tribes of Siksika, the Piikuni, the Kainai; the Stoney Nakoda First Nation tribes of Chiniki, Bearspaw, and Wesley; and the Tsuut'ina First Nation on who's lands we compete.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Event is multiple days spanning Friday May 5th to Sunday May 7th:
 - May 5th will be dedicated to event Check in & Weigh ins.
 - May 6th and 7th are competition days.
- Check in & weigh in are **mandatory** to all competitors.
- No Check In and/or weigh in will result in a forfeit from any divisions registered and NO refund.
- Saturday: a late check in option will be available for Underbelt divisions **ONLY** from 08:00AM MST until 10:00AM MST.
- Events are scheduled to begin at 10:00AM MST, competitors **MUST** be on time.
- Weigh ins will be held at the venue location: Chief Jim Starlight Centre.
- Registration will be completed on Smoothcomp (minus your check in & weigh in).
- Ensure you have read **ALL** rules before registering.
- <u>Normal registration</u>: Open until April 22nd 12:00 AM MST. Costs per division are \$60 CAD for the first 3 divisions, after your 3rd division (4+) each division will cost only \$45 CAD.
- <u>Late registration:</u> April 22nd 12:00 AM MST to April 28th 12:00AM MST. Each division will cost \$85 CAD and no discount will be applied for any number of registered divisions.
- Last chance to register or edit for an event will be April 28th 12:00AM MST.
- If you do not register for your desired divisions before April 22nd, there will be a late fee applied to division costs.
- You may cancel your registration for a full refund until April 22nd at 12:00AM MST.
- No registrations will be permitted at the event.

BASIC RULES

Rules for our event are nothing unique. Like all martial arts events, ensure you are respectful of all those around you including spectators, competitors, referees, volunteers, venue, etc. Everyone at the event has the responsibility to maintain a respectful environment. WKU officials also reserve the right to remove any persons from the event or disqualify an individual, including spectators and competitors, should they have performed any misconduct towards the aforementioned.

Misconduct can come in many forms but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal abuse or derogatory language directed towards an individual with malice intent.
- Verbal or physical threats that are intended to harm an individual beyond that of competition.
- Theft or vandalization of property owned, or rented by others or of the venue itself.
- Any form of substance abuse (Alcohol, Marijuana, etc.) at the event, or present whilst inebriated or under influence.

In short, please ensure you conduct yourself as though you are at your dojo and remember you are representing your dojo, instructors, and teammates.

Competitors must be aware of their division's rules for example; illegal techniques that would result in fouls, contact rules (Light, Full), all required and well maintained equipment. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in disqualification from the division.

All athletes must ensure they have read the rules for the divisions you wish to enter before registering. The WKU Rules on divisions will be adhered to even though not all divisions listed in the rules will be available at the competition.

UNDERBELT DIVISION

As an opportunity for up and coming martial artists to experience a National competition and compete alongside all the Team Canada qualifying athletes, the National Championships will include an Underbelt Category. This category is available for non-black belts aged 3 and up. This allows those athletes to achieve different goals, have a well-rounded martial arts experience and hopefully mold the next generation of amazing Team Canada athletes.

If participants are below black belt, they are welcome to participate in both the Team Canada qualifier that qualifies them for the World Championships and the Underbelt divisions to get more experience.

Underbelt divisions competitors will be separated by age and skill/belt only for both forms and sparring divisions (Males and Females will compete together).

For Underbelt divisions, rank and belt categories are defined as the following:

- Beginner: under 1 year experience / white of yellow belt
- · Intermediate: 2-3 years experience / Orange or Green belt
- Advanced: 3-4 years experience / Blue, Purple, Brown belt

Below are instructions for registration:

1. Click on "Create account" and complete all fields. Select green "Create Account" button when complete.



2. Select "Accept" on the terms and conditions.
